Literary works can be viewed from an artistic and cultural perspective, where art and culture are not only integral parts of Acehese identity but also serve as a means of maintaining the continuity of ancestral values amidst the tide of modernization (Mujiburrahman et al., 2024).

Through literature, communities build a shared understanding of identity, history, and value systems that distinguish them from other cultural groups. Acehese literature is a crucial pillar in maintaining the continuity of Acehese cultural identity. This is because this culture has given rise to various social customs, including regional languages, dances, music, and traditional ceremonies, all of which are the result of cultural elements (Ramadhan et al., 2024). In addition, Acehese literature and language can be used as a means to encourage social harmony and cultural diversity (Munidar, 2024). The findings of this study explain that the development of the times, globalization, and the dominance of modern popular culture pose serious challenges to the sustainability of Acehese literature. The rapid development of globalization and modernization currently carries a high risk of causing the erosion or even disappearance of local culture because it is not passed on to the younger generation. Therefore, local wisdom as one of Indonesia's cultural heritages needs to continue to be passed on to the younger generation so that the values of environmental conservation and love of nature remain ingrained (Marpaung & Harahap, 2024). Young people's interest in regional literature is declining, while the use of the Acehese language in everyday life is diminishing. This situation has the potential to weaken Acehese literature's role as a means of shaping and preserving the community's cultural identity.

Based on these conditions, an in-depth study of the role of Acehese literature in shaping the cultural identity of the Acehese people is necessary. This research is crucial for understanding how Acehese literature contributes to instilling cultural values and the extent to which its role remains relevant amid ongoing social and cultural changes. The results of this study are expected to contribute to efforts to preserve Acehese literature and strengthen the cultural identity of the Acehese people today and in the future.
